

AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION
BETWEEN
THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL
SCIENCES,
PHETCHABURI RAJABHAT UNIVERSITY, THAILAND
AND
THE FACULTY OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES,
SOUTHWEST FORESTRY UNIVERSITY, KUNMING,
CHINA

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Phetchaburi Rajabhat University (PBRU), Phetchaburi, Thailand (Party B) and The Faculty of Foreign Languages, Southwest Forestry University (SWFU), Kunming, China (Party A).

In order to open up a new page for cooperation and foster excellent co-operational relationship between the two universities, the two institutions have agreed to the following framework based upon principles of mutual equality and reciprocity of benefits:

I. Program description

The two institutions have agreed to establish a “3+1” educational cooperation program, which involves the Chinese major students in Phetchaburi Rajabhat University (PBRU), who are to study in Southwest Forestry University (SWFU) for the 3rd academic year and in PBRU for the rest of the 3 years. Beginning from 2017, PBRU is to send its Chinese major students to SWFU each year at the end of August or the beginning of September. The students and the faculty appointed will be provided access to the appropriate university resources at SWFU during their stay there.

II. The responsibilities of Party A

1. Provide good quality teaching and learning conditions to the Chinese major students from PBRU according to the curriculum agreed upon by the two parties. Be responsible to keep records of the students' academic performances and issue certificates to those qualified.
2. Prepare and provide accommodations for the students at the fee agreed upon: 800yuan a semester and 1600yuan a year for both male students and female students.
3. Provide transportation between the airport and PBRU with fee included in the tuition.

4. Organize related necessary activities, such as the cultural courses (for example the Loy kratong festival), Chinese cooking, traditional Chinese festivals, field trips, etc. with fee included in the tuition.
5. Help arrange accommodations for the PBRU teacher who is appointed to accompany the students to SWFU and may stay for a few days if necessary/ needed, with the fee included.
6. Appoint a liaison mandated to coordinate all aspects of the program. Refer to Item 4 in Part IV.

III. The responsibilities of Party B

1. Prepare and consult with Party A about the curriculum.
2. Get the students ready to study in SWFU for one year.
3. Pay the tuition and accommodation fee to SWFU when the students arrive at SWFU. The tuition fee for each student is 8,000yuan a year; and the accommodation fee is 1,600yuan a year for both male and female students.
4. Appoint a Thai teacher to accompany the students to SWFU and help with their settling down in SWFU.
5. Appoint a liaison mandated to coordinate all aspects of the programs. Refer to Item 4 in Part IV
6. Contact SWFU at least one month before the students set off to SWFU each year.


IV. Program Review

1. The Agreement between Phetchaburi Rajabhat University and Southwest Forestry University will be in effect for a period of five years following the latest date of signature by responsible officials. Thereafter it shall be automatically renewed each year.
2. Modification of this Agreement during the period of its effective dates can take place with the written approval of both parties.
3. Cancellation of this Agreement by either party during the period of its effective dates requires a six-month period between written notice and cancellation.
4. At Phetchaburi Rajabhat University, the contact officer will be the Head of the Office of International Cooperation or of The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences or designate. At Southwest Forestry University, the contact officer will be the Head of the Faculty of Foreign Languages or designate.

In witness thereof, the parties hereto have caused this Memorandum of Agreement to be duly executed by their authorized officers as of the dates indicated below.


